

Infrastructure development scheme for dairy co-operatives

PANAJI: The government of Goa has notified the scheme and pattern of financial assistance to the dairy co-operative societies in the state in the form of grant for their development/smooth functioning of business and other allied activities.

This scheme will be called 'Infrastructure Development Scheme for Dairy Cooperatives' by way of grant to meet the administrative/managerial expenses on staff salaries and allowances, wages, office expenses, rent rates and

taxes, and equipment.

The objective of the scheme is to strengthen grassroots cooperative movement, enable village cooperatives to become economically viable and raise better infrastructure for primary dairy societies.

The dairy cooperative societies which are regularly supplying milk to the milk union will be entitled to avail financial support in the form of grant on the following pattern on yearly basis subject to availability of funds for daily collection of milk.

For above 500 liters

per day will be given a grant of Rs 1.50 lakh, for 300-500 liters per day Rs 1 lakh and for 150-300 liters per day Rs 75,000 will be provided.

Detail guidelines of the scheme are as follows: the society shall submit the milk supply report from the milk union for the period for which the assistance is applied for along with proposal. The scheme is applicable to the societies only after one year of its registration.

The concerned assistant registrar shall certify the correctness of the milk supply report of the society by verifying

the records of the same.

The society shall submit the proposal to the concerned assistant registrar in the prescribed application along with all the requirements. The government may relax/modify any of the above conditions if deemed necessary. The society shall approve the proposal for utilisation of government assistance in the general body/special general body before submitting the proposal to the concerned office of assistant registrar. The registering authority shall verify the utilisation of the grants released.

GSL's dairy project inaugurated at Pernem
