

**GOA SHIPYARD LTD. SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR SC/ST/OBC STUDENTS
IN GOA**

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT

The Scheme shall be called as **Scholarship Scheme for Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe /Other Backward Classes students in Goa (Amended 2020)**.

The Revised Scheme shall be effective from 18.06.2020.

2. OBJECTIVES

The objective of the Scheme is to provide financial support to promote education of students belonging to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe /Other Backward Class residing in the State of Goa.

3. DEFINITIONS

In this Scheme, unless the context otherwise requires: -

- i. **INCOME CERTIFICATE** means Annual Income Certificate of the parent issued by the Competent Authority as per the Government Directives and Orders issued from time to time in this regard.
- ii. **RESIDENTIAL/DOMICILE CERTIFICATE** means Certificate issued by the Competent Authority of State Government of Goa indicating the number of years of residence of the Student in the State of Goa
- iii. **GOVERNMENT** means the State Government of Goa as well as the Central Government of India, New Delhi.



4. SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT AND NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

The Scholarships shall be given as mentioned below:

5. ELIGIBILITY

The Eligibility criteria for Scholarship award are:

- i. The Scheme shall apply to all Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe / Other Backward Class students, who are residents of the state of Goa and also pursuing their studies in the state of Goa. The students have to produce Residence/Domicile certificate and Caste certificate from Appropriate Authority to support their claim. Further, the domicile Students of Goa who wish to pursue Engineering or Medical Degree courses and have secured admission in any other State will become eligible for the Scholarship on fulfilling the income ceiling criteria & submission of necessary document /certificate from the appropriate Authority.
- ii. **The annual income of the parents of the Students should not exceed Rs. 6,00,000/- per annum.**

- iii. The students should have secured admission for the courses on full time basis recognised by the State Govt/Govt of India. Scholarships will not be granted to the Students who pursue Degree Courses /Diploma Courses through distance Education/Correspondence Courses or part-time basis.
- iv. The Student has to score a minimum of 50% marks in the preceding examination i.e. 50% marks in Xth / XIIth for being eligible for Scholarship award for 1st year Diploma / Degree course, 50% marks in 1st year for being eligible for Scholarship award for 2nd year and so on.
- v. The student has to submit Proof of admission of the following year of course i.e. Admission proof for diploma/degree course after Xth / XIIth, admission proof for second year course after 1st year and so on.
- vi. Students who are gainfully employed either in full time or part time will not be entitled to the Scholarship.

6. **SELECTION PROCESS**

- i. Every year press release will be given in local Newspapers and the advertisement will also be uploaded on the official website of Goa Shipyard Limited.
- ii. A Selection Committee shall be constituted with the approval of CMD consisting of minimum 05 members as follows:

CGM / GM	- Chairman
SC/ST Representative	- Member
OBC Representative-	- Member
Finance Representative	- Member
Welfare Officer	- Member Secretary
- iii. Applications in the prescribed format [Annexure 'A'] duly filled by the candidates shall be scrutinized by the Selection Committee on the basis of the criteria mentioned in this Scheme. The committee recommendations should bring out appropriate distribution of scholarships mentioned at Clause 4 among the various academic years.



- iv. In case, the number of candidates exceed the number of available scholarships, the committee will select the candidates based on merit in their previous examination (i.e. Xth or XIIth examination for Scholarship award for 1st year Diploma/Degree, 1st year examination for Scholarship award for 2nd year course and so on). If the candidates have scored equal marks in their previous examination then preference shall be given to the student with lower family income. Incase family income is also same then, the date of birth shall be checked wherein the older will be given preference.

7. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- i. The Scholarships shall be disbursed every year on the occasion of Independence Day i.e. 15th August.
- ii. Preference shall be given to girl students.
- iii. The Scholarship amount will be reviewed after every 05 years. The same should be recommended by the Director (Finance) and approved by CMD.
- iv. The recipients of this scholarship Awards shall not have any preference in the matter of recruitment for any post in the company.
- v. A Declaration shall be taken from the students that they have not availed or shall not avail any financial assistance / Scholarship through any other Schemes for that Academic year for which scholarship has been granted.
- vi. In case any information furnished by the student in connection with the above scholarship is found to be false, incorrect or concocted at any stage or any information is found to have been suppressed, the scholarship shall be deemed to have been obtained by deceitful means and the scholarship will be cancelled and the student shall be barred from any future Scholarships from GSL.
- vii. The Financial implication towards grant of scholarship every year shall be approved by Chairman & Managing Director with recommendation of



Director (Finance) after taking into account factors like affordability, capacity to pay & performance of the Company. Based on these factors CMD may vary the number or amount towards scholarships for a particular year. Further, in case of Loss in any particular year the grant of scholarship shall not be operated for next financial year.

8. Chairman & Managing Director (CMD) **shall be the Competent Authority in the interpretation /modification / amendment / addition / deletion to this Scheme for administrative purposes.**
